## Last Meeting: Meyer Real Estate Group

Pat Hart, CEO of the Meyer Real Estate Group, told us about the projects they have going on in the Dickinson area. Since their focus is providing quality construction for a sustainable community, Dickinson appeared to be the prime place in the Bakken oil region for them to locate. They looked closely at the NDSU growth study and the city's comprehensive plan to determine how they could best meet the community's needs.

Pat described the 85-acre industrial park on north Highway 22 behind Power Fuels, the renovated City Walk Apartments north of the mall, Sundance Cove on East 21st (45 rental townhouses), and the Pine Crest Addition in west Dickinson. Pine Crest is set to be a destination retail center with a manufactured home community behind it. The 400 homes would be part of a Home Owners Association with strict covenants.

The Meyer Group also has a "Fresh Start" credit program where the goal is to get clients out of rentals and into home ownership.
